Any Collie owner who has a dog that has not been tested may wish to participate in our subsidies program. These tests are currently available. Subsidies are available as noted below only. There is a 30 day wait period for new members.

ALL SUBSIDIES ARE FOR ROUGH AND SMOOTH COLLIES ONLY owned by the member. CHF does not give subsidies for tests done through other testing agencies, even if for a health issue listed here.

Dermatomyositis DMS	Dermatomyositis is an inflammatory disease affecting skin as well as muscle, in extreme cases. This is an auto-immune disease in rare cases can be fatal. PRA	An abnormal development (dysplasia) of the rods & cones (the light sensitive cells in the eye) that leads to an early onset of night blindness that is typically apparent by the time pups are 6 weeks of age. In most cases, the rcd20 affected dog is completely blind by the time it is 1 year old. There is late onset PRA striking dogs 4 years or older.
