Responsible Collie breeders will want to take advantage of the health tests and be involved in ongoing studies that can be done for Collies you want to breed so that you can be sure that the dogs you produce have the best chance at a long, happy life. Any Collie owner who has a dog that has not been tested may wish to participate in our subsidies program. These tests are currently available. Subsidies are available only as noted below. There is a 30 day wait period for new members.

**ALL SUBSIDIES ARE FOR PUREBRED ROUGH AND SMOOTH COLLIES ONLY owned by the member. CHF does not give subsidies for tests done through other testing agencies, even if for a health issue listed here.**

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| PRA       | An abnormal development (dysplasia) of the rods & cones (the light sensitive cells in the eye) that leads to an early onset of night blindness that is typically apparent by the time pups are 6 weeks of age. In most cases, the rcd20 affected dog is completely blind by the time it is 1 year old.
